

### LECTURES (FREE)

Every week from 11:00 to 12:00 and from 17:00 to 18:00, we offer the following cultural lectures: Mondays: "Regions of Spain", Tuesdays: "Traditions and legends of Spain", and Thursdays: Spanish Art. These lectures introduce students to Spanish tradition through history, art, and literature, helping them have a better understanding of our current society.

### DIPLOMA (FREE)

At the end of each course, students will take an exam which, along with a progress report from their teacher, will determine whether or not the student has obtained the skills to pass onto the next level or to receive a certificate of course completion. Regardless of course completion, every student will receive a certificate of attendance.

In order to obtain any of the certificates mentioned above, or to be able to advance to the next level, it is mandatory to have attended at least 90% of the classes.

Students who start at the school after the first week of the month may join a course which has already started at their corresponding level.

**Note:** The start date of each level (the first Monday of each month) is indicated in the registration form.

## Types of courses in colegio Delibes

We have 4, 5 or 6-hour-per-day courses. All the courses are based on course A, to which one or two extra hours are added.

The extra hour takes place from 13:00 to 14:00. For course G, which has two extra hours, you will be able to choose the sixth hour from 16:00 to 17:00 or from 17:00 to 18:00.

### course a. intensive Spanish language\*

This is the most suitable course for the majority of our students. This intensive course allows you to learn quickly and to participate in the school's programmed activities where you will continue to learn outside of the classroom.

During the first two hours, you will be taught various grammatical topics which will be supported by a variety of exercises. Grammar will also include the correction of sentences, examples, as well as structural work on texts. The following two hours will be devoted to conversation including oral and written expression, vocabulary, colloquial phrases, as well as reading and listening comprehension. Debates about current events, as well as discussions about important topics take place daily.

### course b. 1 hr. extra intensive Spanish language and culture

This course allows you to study Spanish culture further than other topics. You will be able to experience the real Spain through its history, arts, gastronomy, and other cultural topics.

Levels for course b: from B1 to C2 (7 levels).

### course c. 1 hr. extra intensive Spanish language and literature

You will study the key centuries and styles of Spanish literature through the most significant authors and their works. Both prose and poetry texts will be analyzed, books will be recommended, and literary commentaries will be given.

Levels for course c: from B1 to C2 (7 levels).

### course d. 1 hr. extra intensive Spanish language and oral interaction

You will cover colloquial expressions, debates, and discussions on current texts. Students who have a beginner level of Spanish will be familiarized with basic vocabulary which will enable them to get around and travel in Spain independently and with confidence.

Levels for course d: from A1 to C2 (10 levels).

### course e. 1 hr. extra intensive Spanish language and inverse translation

Inverse translation with four options:

English-Spanish • German-Spanish • French-Spanish • Italian-Spanish  
There are different types of works covered during class such as periodical, literary, social, political, and economic.

Levels for course e: from B1 to C2 (7 levels).

### course f. 1 hr. extra intensive Spanish language and tourism

You will cover the physical, political, and human geography of Spain as well as natural and cultural resources of tourism, and the impact of tourism in Spain.

Levels for course f: from B1 to C2 (7 levels).

### course g. 2 hrs. extra superintensive Spanish language

There are five options for the first extra hour: Culture (Course B) - Literature (Course C) - Oral Interaction (Course D) - Translation (Course E) - Tourism (Course F). For the second extra hour, we have the following topics: Monday: Colloquial conversation, Tuesday: Short writing exercises, Wednesday: Commentary of texts, Thursday: Formal conversation, Friday: Spanish cooking.

Levels for course g: from A1 to C2 (10 levels).



## course h. business Spanish\*

This course is ideal for students looking to expand their knowledge of the commercial language. It is designed for companies, executives, and students of economics and tourism.

**1st hour:** Commercial correspondence, types of letters, and C.V's. **2nd hour:** Analysis and discussion of contemporary articles from specialized economic publications, the role of Spain in the EU, and topics on macro and microeconomics.

## course i. preparation for D.E.L.E. diploma\* (Diploma of Spanish as a foreign language)

Each year we start the preparation for these exams at the beginning of February and also at the beginning of September.

During the first two hours of this class, theoretical and practical aspects of grammar will be studied. In the 3rd and 4th hours, specific aspects of the exam will be reviewed: reading and listening comprehensions, personal interviews, written skills, essays, exercises on technical vocabulary. Before the test, past exam papers will be reviewed in class.

The D.E.L.E. is the only official diploma recognized by the Spanish State. This exam can be taken in Spain or in Cervantes institutes and Spanish embassies around the world. It takes place at various times throughout the year.

Students with a level below the requirement must have had previous training before the beginning of the D.E.L.E. course to guarantee success in the exam. Students who miss two D.E.L.E. classes without a justified reason will automatically be transferred to a standard Course A.

## course j. minigroup intensive Spanish language\*

This course is ideal for students with little free time and with a special interest in increasing their knowledge more quickly.

## course k. individual intensive Spanish language\*

This is a course aimed towards executives with little free time or students who wish to prepare for a specific exam for their school or university. The student can choose between the subjects of grammar, conversation, translation, economics, literature, or history.

## course l. teaching Spanish as a foreign language\*

The methodology-of-Spanish-teaching course covers theory and practice, resources and strategies, and samples of lessons and practices. Teachers will study the specific learning and teaching difficulties of T.S.F.L. **Course:** 15 hours of lessons per week.

## course m. for groups

Colegio Delibes organizes special programmes for short stay groups of one or more weeks. These programs combine lessons and extracurricular activities such as cultural visits, films, lectures, excursions, sports, and parties.

We offer our students five different possibilities for lodging in Salamanca during their course:

- With a Spanish host family.
- In a student residence.
- In a flat shared with other students.
- In a private studio (minimum 4 weeks).
- In a hotel or hostel.

All our families' homes, like our flats, residences, and the hotels that we work with, are located in the city center within a maximum of 15 minutes' walk to the Plaza Mayor and to the school.

All our options have everything you will need to live comfortably and to enjoy a pleasant stay in Salamanca. If a student is not entirely satisfied for any reason in their accommodation, they should inform the school within the first three days of their stay and we will work quickly to find an alternative.

On the registration form, you should state the start date of your intended course and the start date of your accommodation. Students living with host families, in hotels, or in the student residence can go directly to their accommodation upon arrival. They can have a taxi to drop them off directly at the address in their confirmation letter. Students living in shared apartments or private studios should phone the school mobile number provided in the confirmation letter to inform us of the approximate arrival time in Salamanca.

A staff member will meet the student and take him or her to their accommodation. In order to help our students with any problem that might arise, the school mobile will be available 24 hours a day.

You will find the mobile number in your confirmation letter.

## families

All our families that host Delibes students have been carefully chosen and are guaranteed to treat you well, offer quality food, wifi, and provide clean houses.

Living with a family has various advantages. You will learn for yourself about the Spanish customs, food, routines, and way of life, through your own experiences. It gives you the opportunity to practice the language all day long while expanding your vocabulary and improving your pronunciation. In short, it is the best way to fully integrate into Spanish life. This type of accommodation is offered throughout the year.

There are four possibilities for living with families:

- Single room and full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner).
- Single room and half board (breakfast and lunch or dinner).
- Double room and full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner).
- Double room and half board (breakfast and lunch or dinner).

Students must bring their own towels. The family will provide blankets, sheets and duvets. On the first day, students will receive the key to their family's house in order to come and go as they wish. Laundry **once a week** is included in the price. Ironing it is not included.

## With a host family, in a student residence, or in a shared flat

If the course you choose will last more than a few months, we also offer the opportunity to reserve mixed accommodation, for example, beginning the first month with a family and then moving to a student flat or residence.

### residences

Colegio Delibes has its own residence in Salamanca. It is in the city center, 5 minutes' walk from the Plaza Mayor and 10 minutes from the school. It has 50 bedrooms, shared and single, three sitting rooms, a patio and all modern facilities.

In the residence, students of all nationalities live together creating a very international environment. Acquiring experiences and anecdotes from all over the world further enriches our students.

Students must bring their own towels. The residence provides bedclothes. There is accommodation in the residence throughout the year, but with limited space available.

#### Four possibilities:

- Single room and full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner).
- Single room and half board (breakfast and lunch or dinner).
- Double room and full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner).
- Double room and half board (breakfast and lunch or dinner).

Laundry is included in the price. Ironing is not included.

### studios

These are small apartments for one or two people, with a bedroom (single or double), a bathroom, and an open kitchen connected to a small lounge.

If you choose this option, then you must reserve it well in advance, as we have limited availability.

**If you arrive in Salamanca on Saturday, let us know and we will book a reasonably priced hotel for you at your cost.**

### shared flats

These flats have multiple rooms, both singles and doubles, two bathrooms, a kitchen, and a sitting room. They have central heating and hot water. They are equipped with all the furniture necessary to make your stay pleasant and comfortable. All of the bedrooms have a bed, wardrobe, desk and chair, a small table, and shelves. The kitchen is supplied with all the necessary utensils (pots, pans, plates, glasses, etc). All flats have a washing machine and a fridge. In the sitting-room there is a large table on which to eat, a television, a sideboard cabinet and a sofa. Students must bring their own towels. The school provides bedclothes.

#### There are two possibilities:

- Single room.
- Double room.

This type of accommodation also has its advantages. As they are shared flats, you will make friends quickly with other students from the school. In a flat, you will enjoy greater freedom, but at the same time it requires greater responsibility, as students must cook, clean, and respect the needs of their other roommates. Flats will be cleaned by the school at least once a week.






### Excursions



Over the weekends we offer different excursions to different cities in Spain. We run them in collaboration with a well-known travel agency in Salamanca, making these excursions available to both Spanish and foreign students.

The excursions are always accompanied by guides from our school who show and explain the history and monuments of the city in detail.

One-day excursions are run on Saturday and Sunday and are confirmed with a minimum of 20 registered students.

The price for these excursions ranges from 40 to 50 euros per person.

### Visits to various museums in Madrid



**MADRID:** Guided tour around the city, Prado and Reina Sofia museums, the Retiro Park, and the Plaza Mayor.

**TOLEDO:** The entire city is an artistic and cultural monument.

**SEGOVIA:** Known for its Roman aqueduct and its old city centre.

**ÁVILA:** with an impressive wall that circles the city.

**ZAMORA:** Romanic in its maximum splendor.

**LA ALBERCA:** A historic and picturesque medieval village in La Sierra de Francia.

**AVEIRO (Portugal):** We go to our neighbouring village to visit the old city center, known as 'The Portuguese Venice', and then we spend the afternoon on the beach, where we have lunch and enjoy the sun and the ocean.

We only have these parties in spring and summer. We leave Salamanca in the morning and return in the evening.

Students and teachers prepare lunch and dinner together, organize games, sunbathe, enjoy the swimming-pool and spend a nice day in the "charro" countryside.

# Guarantees and obligations of colegio Delibes

## We guarantee in our courses

1. Availability of all the levels and courses offered in this brochure, no matter the number of students in each level.
2. A maximum of 12 students per class.
3. Correct and adequate placement of each student through an oral and written test.
4. An exam on the last Thursday of each month, obtaining a certificate of course completion, and/or progress assessment to pass to the next level (for those studying for several months).
5. Native teachers with a degree in Philology.

## We guarantee in our accommodation

1. Accommodation is selected following strict rules and requirements, is revised and updated periodically, and is located within a 15 minute walking distance from the school and the city center.
2. The possibility to change the accommodation provided there is an unfulfilment of any characteristics described in this brochure.

## We guarantee in our activities

1. Detailed program of activities throughout the week, with organization and accompaniment by colegio Delibes' teachers.
2. A minimum of 70% of free activities throughout the week.
3. An offer of two excursions every weekend – on Saturdays and Sundays.

## We guarantee in our services

1. Significant discounts in bookshops, restaurants, and bars, etc. The establishments that offer these discounts are those that have a signed agreement with Colegio Delibes, the names of which will be published on the information leaflet that you will be given on the first day.
2. The confirmation and booking of flight tickets and accommodation.

## How do you get to Salamanca?

The quickest and most direct way to travel is by plane to Madrid or Valladolid. From there, busses and trains leave for Salamanca every hour from 7:00am to 10:00pm. The journey from Madrid to Salamanca takes approximately two and a half hours, (from Valladolid just one hour) in which you will be able to enjoy the most varied countryside. You could also travel to Salamanca by bus or train if you are coming from Europe. There is a direct line (with 2 journeys per week) that passes through various countries.

We also offer the option of a direct and private transfer service from the Madrid airport to Salamanca and from the Valladolid airport to Salamanca. If you are interested in this option, please consult us.

We have a private escort service to meet students in the Madrid airport and escort them to the bus that arrives regularly to Salamanca from the airport. If you are interested in this service, please contact us.






